Introduction:

- 1. This is a notice to inform you of our policy about all information that we record about you. It sets out the conditions under which we may process any information that we collect from you, or that you provide to us. It covers information that could identify you ("personal information") and information that could not. In the context of the law and this notice, "process" means collect, store, transfer, use or otherwise act on information.
- 2. We regret that if there are one or more points below with which you are not happy, your only recourse is to leave our website immediately.
- 3. We take seriously the protection of your privacy and confidentiality. We understand that all visitors to our website are entitled to know that their personal data will not be used for any purpose unintended by them and will not accidentally fall into the hands of a third party.
- 4. We undertake to preserve the confidentiality of all information you provide to us and hope that you reciprocate.
- 5. Our policy complies with South African law accordingly implemented, including that required by the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

- 7. Except as set out below, we do not share, or sell, or disclose to a third party, any information without proper authorization.

How we get the personal information and what we use is for:

Most of the personal information we process is provided to us directly by you for one of the following reasons:

- Open an account with ChannelPort (PTY) Ltd
- Become an employee of ChannelPort (PTY) Ltd
- Deliver goods to you via our courier services
- Remuneration for employees
- Payment of creditors
- SEESA secure central management of labour, payroll, profiling etc
 We also receive personal information indirectly, from the following sources in the following scenarios:
- Underwriter (ie CGIC/TradeUnion) approving or declining dealer application. No reason supplied
 for declining dealer applications, but ChannelPort (PTY) Ltd is aware of bad credit records, hence
 the potential customer being declined.

We use the information that you have given us, in order to:

• Process dealer applications that we submit to CGIC for approval for credit

Process payments for salaries and supplier invoices

We may share this information with:

- Credit Guarantee companies like CGIC or Trade Union
- SEESA

When will we process your personal information:

In terms of the Protection of Personal Information Act (POPIA), the justification ground which we base our processing on consist out of the following:

- The data subject or a competent person where the data subject is a child **consents** to the processing. Kindly note that you have the right to withdraw your consent;
- The processing is **necessary** to carry out actions for the conclusion or performance of a contract to which the data subject is a party;
- The processing complies with an **obligation** imposed by law on the business;
- The processing protects a **legitimate** interest of the data subject;
- The processing is necessary for the proper performance of a public law duty by the business;
 Or
- The processing is necessary for pursuing the legitimate **interests** of the business or of a third party to whom the information is supplied.

How we store your personal information:

Your information is securely stored:

We keep your information for 3 Years. We will then dispose all information by shredding any paperwork (if applicable) and/or delete any electronic copies on server and backup NAS device. Should you still be an active client on our database, nothing will be destroyed until time of termination.

All dealer applications are received electronically and no paperwork is accepted. After CGIC approval and loaded onto Pastel Accounting Software, the e-mail is deleted immediately.

All POD's are scanned and kept on local secure server and backed up to NAS device. POD's are then filed and stored in secure and locked storage area.

Your data protection rights:

- You are entitled to access your personal data by sending a written request to info@channelport.co.za. We may charge you a fee for this service.
- You may also request **ChannelPort (PTY) Ltd** to correct or supplement any of your personal data with the **Accounts Department**, which will undertake as soon as practicable.
- Request the destruction of your personal data. The Directors will consider your request in light of
 any other laws or regulations prohibiting ChannelPort (PTY) Ltd from destroying your personal
 data.

You are not required to pay any charge for exercising your rights. If you make a request, we have one month to respond to you.
